

AN ACT

Affecting the representation of the majority and minority membership of the Senate Members of the Joint Economic Committee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding any other provision of law, and spe-
4 cifically section 5(a) of the Employment Act of 1946 (15
5 U.S.C. 1024(a)), the Members of the Senate to be ap-
6 pointed by the President of the Senate shall for the dura-
7 tion of the One Hundred Seventh Congress, for so long
8 as the majority party and the minority party have equal
9 representation in the Senate, be represented by five Mem-
10 bers of the majority party and five Members of the minor-
11 ity party.
