3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF ROBERT WAYNE JENKINS**

4 **STATION.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

6 Postal Service located at 6910 South Yorktown Avenue

1 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and known as the “Southside Sta-
2 tion”, shall be known and designated as the “Robert
3 Wayne Jenkins Station”.

4 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
7 be deemed to be a reference to the Robert Wayne Jenkins
8 Station.
