A BILL

To designate certain lands in the Valley Forge National
Historical Park as the Valley Forge National Cemetery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF LANDS AS VALLEY FORGE**

4 **NATIONAL CEMETERY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not more than 200 acres of land
6 located within the Valley Forge National Historical Park
7 on the day before the date of the enactment of this Act
8 are hereby designated as the Valley Forge National Ceme-
9 tery. Administrative jurisdiction over such lands is hereby
10 transferred to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs and such

1 lands shall be administered as a national cemetery in ac-
2 cordance with chapter 24 of title 38, United States Code
3 (relating to national cemeteries and memorials).

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF PARK BOUNDARIES.—Sub-
5 section (b) of section 2 of the Act entitled “An Act to
6 authorize the Secretary of the Interior to establish the
7 Valley Forge National Historical Park in the Common-
8 wealth of Pennsylvania, and for other purposes” (16
9 U.S.C. 410aa–1) is amended by striking “map entitled
10 ‘Valley Forge National Historical Park’, dated June 1979,
11 and numbered VF–91,001” and inserting “map entitled
12 ‘Valley Forge National Historical Park’, dated _____, and
13 numbered _____”.

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
