## RESOLUTION

Designating the week beginning September 15, 2002, as  
“National Civic Participation Week”.

Whereas the United States embarks on this new millennium as the world’s model of democratic ideals, economic enterprise, and technological innovation and discovery;

Whereas our Nation’s preeminence is a tribute to our great 2-century-old experiment in representative government that nurtures those ideals, fosters economic vitality, and encourages innovation and discovery;

Whereas representative government is dependent on the exercise of the privileges and responsibilities of its citizens, and that has been in decline in recent years in both civic and political participation;



1           (2) proclaims National Civic Participation Week  
2           as a week of inauguration of programs and activities  
3           that will lead to greater participation in elections  
4           and the political process; and

5           (3) requests that the President issue a procla-  
6           mation calling upon interested organizations and the  
7           people of the United States to promote programs  
8           and activities that take full advantage of the techno-  
9           logical resources available in fostering civic partici-  
10          pation through the dissemination of information.
