Mr. NEY (for himself and Mr. LARSON of Connecticut) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of the Biographical Directory of
the United States Congress, 1774–2005.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PRINTING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There shall be printed as a House
5 document a revised edition of the Biographical Directory
6 of the United States Congress for the period ending with
7 the 108th Congress.

8 (b) SPECIFICATIONS.—The document described in
9 subsection (a) shall be in the style, form, manner, and
10 binding as directed by the Joint Committee on Printing

1 after consultation with the Clerk of the House of Rep-
2 resentatives and the Secretary of the Senate. The Clerk
3 of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the
4 Senate shall each provide appropriate biographical data
5 and other material for the document, including data for—

6 (1) Senators and individuals who have served in
7 both the Senate and the House of Representatives,
8 to be provided by the Secretary of the Senate; and

9 (2) Members of the House of Representatives
10 (including Delegates and Resident Commissioners to
11 the Congress), to be provided by the Clerk of the
12 House of Representatives.

13 (c) NUMBER OF COPIES.—In addition to the usual
14 number, there shall be printed with suitable binding the
15 lesser of—

16 (1) 1,280 copies of the document, of which 250
17 shall be for the use of the Senate, 930 copies shall
18 be for the use of the House of Representatives, and
19 100 copies shall be for the use of the Joint Com-
20 mittee on Printing; or

21 (2) a number of copies that does not have a
22 total production and printing cost of more than
23 \$96,500.
