To extend the authority for the construction of a memorial to Martin Luther King, Jr., in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR CONSTRUC-**
4 **TION OF MEMORIAL TO MARTIN LUTHER**
5 **KING, JR.**

6 (a) EXTENSION.—Subsection (b) of section 508 of
7 the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act
8 of 1996 (Public Law 104–333; 110 Stat. 4157; 40 U.S.C.
9 8903 note) is amended to read as follows:

1 “(b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COM-
2 MEMORATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memo-
3 rial shall be in accordance with chapter 89 of title 40,
4 United States Code. Notwithstanding section 8903(e) of
5 such title, the authority provided by this section expires
6 November 12, 2006.”.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Such section is
8 further amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “the Com-
10 memorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.)”
11 and inserting “chapter 89 of title 40, United States
12 Code”; and

13 (2) in subsection (d)—

14 (A) by striking “section 8(b) of the Com-
15 memorative Works Act” and inserting “section
16 8906(b) of title 40, United States Code”;

17 (B) by striking “section 10(b) of that Act”
18 and inserting “subsection (b)”; and

19 (C) by striking “section 8(b)(1) of that
20 Act” and inserting “section 8906(b) of such
21 title”.
