A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the Inland Empire regional recycling project and in the Cucamonga County Water District recycling project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INLAND EMPIRE AND CUCAMONGA COUNTY RE-**
4 **CYCLING PROJECTS.**

5 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the
6 “Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Initiative”.

7 (b) **IN GENERAL.**—The Reclamation Wastewater and
8 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–
9 575, Title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by
10 adding at the end the following:

11 **“SEC. 1635. INLAND EMPIRE REGIONAL WATER RECYCLING**
12 **PROJECT.**

13 “(a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary, in cooperation
14 with the Inland Empire Utilities Agency, may participate
15 in the design, planning, and construction of the Inland
16 Empire regional water recycling project described in the
17 report submitted under section 1606(c).

18 “(b) **COST SHARING.**—The Federal share of the cost
19 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
20 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

21 “(c) **LIMITATION.**—Funds provided by the Secretary
22 shall not be used for operation and maintenance of the
23 project described in subsection (a).

1 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
2 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
3 \$20,000,000.

4 **“SEC. 1636. CUCAMONGA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT.**

5 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in cooperation
6 with the Cucamonga County Water District, may partici-
7 pate in the design, planning, and construction of the
8 Cucamonga County Water District pilot satellite recycling
9 plant in Rancho Cucamonga, California, to reclaim and
10 recycle approximately 2 million gallons per day of domestic
11 wastewater.

12 “(b) COST SHARING.—The Federal share of the cost
13 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
14 25 percent of the capital cost of the project.

15 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary
16 shall not be used for operation and maintenance of the
17 project described in subsection (a).

18 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
19 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section,
20 \$10,000,000.”.

21 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The table of sec-
22 tions in section 2 of Public Law 102–575 is amended by
23 inserting after the item relating to section 1634 the fol-
24 lowing:

“Sec. 1635. Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Program.
“Sec. 1636. Cucamonga County Water Recycling Project.”.
