A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 324 Twenty-Fifth Street in Ogden, Utah, as the “James V. Hansen Federal Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SEC. 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 324 Twenty-Fifth
5 Street in Ogden, Utah, shall be known and designated as
6 the “James V. Hansen Federal Building”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal

1 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
2 a reference to the “James V. Hansen Federal Building”.

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2004.
