A BILL

To amend Public Law 99-338 to authorize the continued use of certain lands within the Sequoia National Park by portions of an existing hydroelectric project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO REISSUE PERMIT.**

2 *The first section of Public Law 99–338 is amended by*
3 *striking “one renewal” and inserting “3 renewals”.*

4 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

5 *Section 3 of Public Law 99–338 is amended to read*
6 *as follows:*

7 *“SEC. 3. The permit shall contain the following provi-*
8 *sions:*

9 *“(1) A prohibition on expansion of the Kaweah*
10 *Project in Sequoia National Park.*

11 *“(2) A requirement that an independent safety*
12 *assessment of the Kaweah Project be conducted, and*
13 *that any deficiencies identified as a result of the as-*
14 *essment would be corrected.*

15 *“(3) A requirement that the Secretary prepare*
16 *and submit to Congress an update of the July 1983*
17 *report on the impact of the operations of the Kaweah*
18 *No. 3 facility on Sequoia National Park.*

19 *“(4) Any other reasonable terms and conditions*
20 *that the Secretary of the Interior deems necessary and*
21 *proper for the management and care of Sequoia Na-*
22 *tional Park and the purposes for which it was estab-*
23 *lished.”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend Pub-
lic Law 99–338 to authorize the continued use of certain

lands within the Sequoia National Park by portions of an existing hydroelectric project, and for other purposes.”.
