## A BILL

To amend the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995 to permit members of the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance to serve for 2 terms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING SECOND TERM FOR BOARD OF DI-**  
4 **RECTORS OF OFFICE OF COMPLIANCE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The second sentence of section  
6 301(e)(1) of the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995  
7 (2 U.S.C. 1381(e)(1)) is amended to read as follows: “A  
8 member of the Board may be reappointed, but no indi-  
9 vidual may serve as a member for more than 2 terms.”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to individuals serv-  
3 ing on the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance  
4 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
