Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4) to reauthorize and improve the program of block grants to States for temporary assistance for needy families, improve access to quality child care, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4) to reauthorize and improve the

1 program of block grants to States for temporary assist-  
2 ance for needy families, improve access to quality child  
3 care, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill  
4 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-  
5 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-  
6 fined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours, with 50  
7 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways  
9 and Means, 40 minutes equally divided and controlled by  
10 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-  
11 mittee on Education and the Workforce, and 30 minutes  
12 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
13 ing minority member of the Committee on Energy and  
14 Commerce. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
15 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill  
16 shall be considered as read. No amendment to the bill shall  
17 be in order except those printed in the report of the Com-  
18 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such  
19 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in  
20 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
21 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-  
22 able for the time specified in the report equally divided  
23 and controlled by the proponent and opponent, and shall  
24 not be subject to amendment. All points of order against  
25 such amendments are waived except that the adoption of

1 an amendment in the nature of a substitute shall con-  
2 stitute the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
3 amendment. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
4 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
5 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
6 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
7 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
8 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
9 with or without instructions.
