A BILL

To convert the temporary judgeship for the district of Nebraska to a permanent judgeship, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRICT JUDGESHIP FOR THE DISTRICT OF**
4 **NEBRASKA.**

5 (a) CONVERSION OF TEMPORARY JUDGESHIP TO
6 PERMANENT JUDGESHIP.—The existing judgeship for the
7 district of Nebraska authorized by section 203(e) of the
8 Judicial Improvements Act of 1990 (28 U.S.C. 133 note;
9 Public Law 101–650) shall, as of the date of enactment
10 of this Act, be authorized under section 133 of title 28,

1 United States Code, and the incumbent in that office shall
2 hold the office under section 133 of title 28, United States
3 Code (as amended by this Act).

4 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—

5 The table contained in section 133(a) of title 28, United
6 States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to
7 Nebraska and inserting the following:

“Nebraska 4”.
