AN ACT

To adjust the boundaries of Green Mountain National
Forest.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GREEN MOUNTAIN NATIONAL FOREST EXPAN-**
2 **SION.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The boundaries of the Green
4 Mountain National Forest are modified to include all par-
5 cels of land depicted on the forest maps entitled “Green
6 Mountain Expansion Area Map I” and “Green Mountain
7 Expansion Area Map II”, each dated February 20, 2002,
8 which shall be on file and available for public inspection
9 in the Office of the Chief of the Forest Service, Wash-
10 ington, District of Columbia.

11 (b) MANAGEMENT.—Federally owned land delineated
12 on the maps acquired for National Forest purposes shall
13 continue to be managed in accordance with the laws (in-
14 cluding regulations) applicable to the National Forest Sys-
15 tem.

16 (c) LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.—For
17 the purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Con-
18 servation Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460l–9), the
19 boundaries of the Green Mountain National Forest, as ad-
20 justed by this Act, shall be considered to be the boundaries
21 of the national forest as of January 1, 1965.
