A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE FEDERAL EN-**
4 **ERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDRO-**
5 **ELECTRIC PROJECT.**

6 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
7 13 of Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would oth-
8 erwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commis-
9 sion project numbered 1651, the Commission may, at the
10 request of the licensee for the project, and after reasonable

1 notice, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,
2 and public interest requirements of that section and the
3 Commission's procedures under that section, extend the
4 time period during which the licensee is required to com-
5 mence the construction of the project for three consecutive
6 two-year periods from the date of the expiration of the
7 extension originally issued by the Commission.
