3 **SECTION 1. SENATOR JAMES B. PEARSON POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 3710 West 73rd Terrace in Prai-

1 rie Village, Kansas, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Senator James B. Pearson Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Senator James B. Pear-
7 son Post Office.
