A BILL

To authorize the use of certain grant funds to establish an information clearinghouse that provides information to increase public access to defibrillation in schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Automatic
5 Defibrillation in Adam’s Memory Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE ACT.**

2 Subsection (c) of section 312 of the Public Health
3 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 244), as amended by Public Law
4 107–188, is amended—

5 (1) at the end of paragraph (5), by striking
6 “and”;

7 (2) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
8 graph (7); and

9 (3) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(6) establish an information clearinghouse that
12 provides information to increase public access to
13 defibrillation in schools; and”.
