Mr. CRAIG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to conduct and support research into alternative treatments for timber produced from public lands and lands withdrawn from the public domain for the National Forest System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Public Lands Produc-
5 tion Research Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 As used in this Act:

1 (1) The term “public lands” has the meaning
2 given such term in section 103(e) of the Federal
3 Land Policy and Management Act (43 U.S.C.
4 1702(e)).

5 (2) The term “National Forest System” has the
6 meaning given such term in section 11(a) of the
7 Forest and Rangeland Renewable Resources Plan-
8 ning Act (16 U.S.C. 1609(a)).

9 (3) The term “Secretaries” means the Sec-
10 retary of Agriculture acting through the Chief of the
11 Forest Service and the Secretary of the Interior act-
12 ing through the Director of the Bureau of Land
13 Management.

14 **SEC. 3. RESEARCH PROGRAM.**

15 The Secretaries shall consult and develop a program
16 of research into alternative treatments for timber and tim-
17 ber products produced from public lands and other federal
18 lands withdrawn from the public domain for the National
19 Forest System, including the use of silver-based biocides
20 using silver produced from patented and unpatented fed-
21 eral lands. The program may be implemented through con-
22 tracts with public or private laboratories or research insti-
23 tutes with experience in the treatment of such products.

1 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums

3 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
