CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of a commemorative document in memory of the late President of the United States, Ronald Wilson Reagan.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE DOCUMENT AUTHORIZED.**

4 A commemorative document in memory of the late
5 President of the United States, Ronald Wilson Reagan,
6 consisting of the eulogies and encomiums for Ronald Wil-
7 son Reagan, as expressed in the Senate and the House
8 of Representatives, together with the texts of the state fu-
9 neral ceremony at the United States Capitol Rotunda, the
10 national funeral service held at the Washington National

1 Cathedral, Washington, District of Columbia, and the in-
2 terment ceremony at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Li-
3 brary, Simi Valley, California, shall be printed as a Senate
4 document, with illustrations and suitable binding.

5 **SEC. 2. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

6 In addition to the usual number of copies printed,
7 there shall be printed the lesser of—

8 (1) 32,500 copies of the commemorative docu-
9 ment, of which 22,150 copies shall be for the use of
10 the House of Representatives and 10,350 copies
11 shall be for the use of the Senate; or

12 (2) such number of copies of the commemora-
13 tive document that does not exceed a production and
14 printing cost of \$1,000,000, with distribution to be
15 allocated in the same proportion as described in
16 paragraph (1).
