Mr. KELLER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To increase the maximum Pell Grant.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pell Grant Increase
5 Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAXIMUM PELL GRANT INCREASE.**

7 Paragraph (2)(A) of section 401(b) of the Higher
8 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(2)(A)) is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 “(2)(A) The amount of the Federal Pell Grant for
11 a student eligible under this part shall be \$6,000 for aca-
12 demic years 2005–2006 through 2010–2011, less an

1 amount equal to the amount determined to be the expected
2 family contribution with respect to that student for that
3 year.”.
