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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5) to improve patient access to health care services and provide improved medical care by reducing the excessive burden the liability system places on the health care delivery system.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 5) to improve  
4 patient access to health care services and provide improved  
5 medical care by reducing the excessive burden the liability

1 system places on the health care delivery system. The bill  
2 shall be considered as read. The previous question shall  
3 be considered as ordered on the bill to final passage with-  
4 out intervening motion except: (1) two hours of debate on  
5 the bill equally divided and controlled by the Majority  
6 Leader and the Minority Leader or their designees; and  
7 (2) one motion to recommit.

8       SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 5 pursuant to  
9 this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the pre-  
10 vious question, the Chair may postpone further consider-  
11 ation of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker.



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
