## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located on Lindbald Avenue, Girdwood, Alaska, as the “Dorothy and Connie Hibbs Post Office Building”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONNIE HIBBS OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located on Lindbald Avenue, in Girdwood,  
6 Alaska, shall be known and designated as the “Dorothy  
7 and Connie Hibbs Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Dorothy and Connie  
3 Hibbs Post Office Building”.
