## A BILL

To amend the Food Stamp Act of 1977 to exclude certain military housing allowances from the eligibility requirements for food stamps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN MILITARY HOUSING**  
4 **ALLOWANCES.**

5 Section 5(d)(1) of the Food Stamp Act of 1977 (7  
6 U.S.C. 2014(d)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (17), by striking “and” at the  
8 end; and

9 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the  
10 following: “, and (19) for the purpose of determining

1 the eligibility of a child who is a member of the  
2 household of a member of a uniformed service, the  
3 amount of a basic allowance provided under section  
4 403 of title 37, United States Code, on behalf of the  
5 member of a uniformed service for housing that is  
6 acquired or constructed under subchapter IV of  
7 chapter 169 of title 10, United States Code”.
