Mr. SANTORUM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain entries of suit pants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ENTRIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
5 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
6 vision of law, upon proper request filed with the Bureau
7 of Customs and Border Protection not later than 180 days
8 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Bureau
9 of Customs and Border Protection shall liquidate or reliq-
10 uidate each entry described in subsection (c), at the rate

1 of duty that would have been applicable to such merchan-
 2 dise if such merchandise had been entered before July 1,
 3 1996, and not subject to duty.

4 (b) REFUND OF AMOUNTS PAID.—Any amounts
 5 owed by the United States pursuant to a request for liq-
 6 uidation or reliquidation of an entry under subsection (a)
 7 shall be paid with interest not later than 180 days after
 8 the date on which the request is made.
