A BILL

To establish the policy of the United States with respect to deployment of missile defense systems capable of defending allies of the United States against ballistic missile attack.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense Against Re-

5 gional Threats Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. ALLIED MISSILE DEFENSE POLICY.**

7 It is the policy of the United States to provide for

8 deployment as soon as is technologically possible of effec-

1 tive missile defense systems capable of defending Israel,
2 Japan, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, and all member
3 nations of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization against
4 ballistic missile attack.

5 **SEC. 3. ALLIED BURDENSARING.**

6 It is the policy of the United States to seek continued
7 negotiated burdensharing agreements with the nations
8 specified in section 2 to share the costs of development
9 and deployment of ballistic missile defense systems.
