1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ATHLETIC FOOTWEAR FOR MEN AND**

4 **BOYS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.64.21	Tennis shoes, basketball shoes, gym shoes, training shoes, and the like for men, youths, and boys, the foregoing with pigskin uppers and outer soles of rubber, plastics, leather, or composition leather (provided for in subheading 6403.99.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.
