## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 39–25 61st Street in Woodside, New York, as the “Thomas J. Manton Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. THOMAS J. MANTON POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 39–25 61st Street in Woodside,  
6 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Thomas  
7 J. Manton Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Thomas J. Manton
- 3 Post Office Building”.
