A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend the minimum medicare deadlines for filing claims to take into account delay in processing adjustments from secondary payor status to primary payor status.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT IN MINIMUM MEDICARE CLAIMS**
4 **FILING DEADLINES TO ACCOUNT FOR DELAY**
5 **IN PROCESSING ADJUSTMENTS FROM SEC-**
6 **ONDARY TO PRIMARY PAYOR STATUS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Sections 1814(a)(1) and
8 1835(a)(1) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.

1 1395f(a)(1), 1395n(a)(1)) are each amended by inserting
2 “(but, in the case of items and services furnished to an
3 individual during the period beginning on the date the in-
4 dividual’s status under section 1862(b)(2) changes from
5 having a group health plan that is a primary plan to no
6 longer having such a health plan that is a primary plan
7 and ending on the date of completion of the change of
8 status, ending no earlier than 1 year after the date of com-
9 pletion of the change of status)” after “1 calendar year”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—(1) The amendments made
11 by subsection (a) shall apply to items and services fur-
12 nished on or after January 1, 1987, and before August
13 11, 1993.

14 (2) In the case of claims for items and services de-
15 scribed in the matter inserted by the amendments made
16 by subsection (a) and furnished on or after January 1,
17 1987, and before August 11, 1993, notwithstanding any
18 other provision of law, the deadline for submission of such
19 claims under parts A and B of title XVIII of the Social
20 Security Act shall in no case expire before the end of the
21 1-year period beginning on the date of the enactment of
22 this Act.

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
