A BILL

To amend the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 to reauthorize the Price-Anderson provisions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Price-Anderson
5 Amendments Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF INDEMNIFICATION AUTHORITY.**

7 (a) INDEMNIFICATION OF NUCLEAR REGULATORY
8 COMMISSION LICENSEES.—Section 170c. of the Atomic
9 Energy Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2210(c)) is amended—

1 (1) in the subsection heading, by striking “**LI-**
2 **CENSES**” and inserting “**LICENSEES**”;

3 (2) by striking “December 1, 2003” and insert-
4 ing “December 1, 2025”; and

5 (3) by striking “December 31, 2003” each
6 place it appears and inserting “December 31,
7 2025”.

8 **SEC. 3. REPORTS.**

9 Section 170p. of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42
10 U.S.C. 2210(p)) is amended by striking “August 1, 1998”
11 and inserting “August 1, 2025”.

12 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

13 The amendments made by this Act take effect on De-
14 cember 1, 2003.
