## A BILL

To expand eligibility for government markers for marked  
graves of veterans at private cemeteries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF GOVERNMENT MARKERS FOR**  
4 **MARKED GRAVES OF VETERANS AT PRIVATE**  
5 **CEMETERIES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 502(d) of the Veterans  
7 Education and Benefits Expansion Act of 2001 (38  
8 U.S.C. 2306 note) is amended by striking “September 11,  
9 2001” and inserting “November 1, 1990”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-  
3 ment of section 502 of the Veterans Education and Bene-  
4 fits Expansion Act of 2001.
