## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide for the transfer of certain contact information for a member of the Armed Forces who is being medically separated or retired under chapter 61 of such title to the department or agency for veterans affairs of the State in which the member intends to reside.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Wounded Warrior In-  
3 formation Sharing Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF MEMBER CONTACT INFORMATION TO**  
5 **STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES FOR**  
6 **VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

7 Section 1142 of title 10, United States Code, is  
8 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
9 section:

10 “(d) TRANSFER OF CONTACT INFORMATION TO  
11 STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES FOR VETERANS  
12 AFFAIRS.—(1) In the case of a member being medically  
13 separated or being retired under chapter 61 of this title,  
14 the Secretary concerned shall ensure (subject to the con-  
15 sent of the member) that the member’s address and con-  
16 tact information is transmitted within 30 days of the sepa-  
17 ration or retirement to the department or agency for vet-  
18 erans affairs of the State in which the member intends  
19 to reside after the separation or retirement.

20 “(2) In this subsection, the term ‘State’ includes the  
21 District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico,  
22 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and  
23 any territory or possession of the United States.”.
