Mr. CASTLE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Rules, and in addition to the Select Committee on Intelligence (Permanent Select), for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To require the House of Representatives and the Senate to each establish a Subcommittee on Intelligence in the Committee on Appropriations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUBCOMMITTEES ON IN-**
4 **TELLIGENCE IN COMMITTEES ON APPRO-**
5 **PRIATIONS.**

6 (a) ESTABLISHMENT; JURISDICTION.—The House of
7 Representatives and the Senate shall each establish in the
8 Committee on Appropriations of the House or Senate (as

1 the case may be) a Subcommittee on Intelligence, which
2 shall have jurisdiction over all activities of such Committee
3 which relate to intelligence and intelligence-related activi-
4 ties of the United States Government.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall apply
6 with respect to the One Hundred Eleventh Congress and
7 each succeeding Congress.

8 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF INTELLIGENCE FUNDING**
9 **INFORMATION.**

10 (a) BUDGET REQUEST OF PRESIDENT.—The Presi-
11 dent shall disclose to the public the aggregate amount of
12 appropriations requested in the budget of the President
13 for the fiscal year concerned for the intelligence and intel-
14 ligence-related activities of the United States Government,
15 together with the amount requested for each element or
16 component of the intelligence community.

17 (b) AMOUNT APPROPRIATED UNDER LAW BY CON-
18 GRESS.—Not later than 30 days after the end of each fis-
19 cal year, the Committees on Appropriations of the House
20 of Representatives and Senate shall jointly issue a public
21 statement of the aggregate amount appropriated or other-
22 wise made available during the fiscal year concerned for
23 the intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the
24 United States Government, together with the amount ap-

1 appropriated or otherwise made available for each element
2 or component of the intelligence community.

3 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
4 respect to fiscal year 2007 and each succeeding fiscal year.
