## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to extend the time limit for the use of education benefits by members of the Selected Reserve and certain members of the reserve component, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME LIMIT FOR USE OF EDU-**  
4 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE BY MEMBERS OF THE**  
5 **SELECTED RESERVE.**

6       Section 16133(a) of title 10, United States Code, is  
7 amended by inserting “that is ten years after the date on  
8 which” after “(2) on the date”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESERVE COMPONENT MEMBERS SUPPORTING**  
2 **CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS.**

3 Section 16164(a) of title 10, United States Code, is  
4 amended as follows:

5 (1) By striking “chapter while serving—” and  
6 inserting “chapter—”.

7 (2) In paragraph (1)—

8 (A) by inserting “while serving” before “in  
9 the Selected Reserve of”; and

10 (B) by striking “; or” and inserting a  
11 semicolon.

12 (3) In paragraph (2)—

13 (A) by inserting “while serving” before “in  
14 the Ready Reserve,”; and

15 (B) by striking the period and inserting “;  
16 or”.

17 (4) By adding at the end the following new  
18 paragraph:

19 “(3) before the date that is ten years after the  
20 last day on which the member is deployed in support  
21 of a contingency operation.”.

22 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATES.**

23 (a) CHAPTER 1606.—The amendment made by sec-  
24 tion 1 shall apply with respect to a person who becomes  
25 eligible for benefits under chapter 1606 of title 10, United  
26 States Code, on or after October 7, 2001.

1       (b) CHAPTER 1607.—The amendments made by sec-  
2 tion 2 shall apply with respect to a person who becomes  
3 eligible for benefits under chapter 1607 of title 10, United  
4 States Code, on or after October 28, 2004.
