1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHEMICAL THAT IS USED FOR DYEING AP-**
4 **PAREL HOME TEXTILES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	3,10-Bis[(2-aminopropylamino)-6,13-dichloro-4,11-triphenodioxazinedisulfonic acid reaction products with 2-amino-1,4-benzenedisulfonic acid, 2-[(4-aminophenylsulfonyl)ethyl hydrogen sulfate and 2,4,6-trifluoro-1,3,5-trifluoro-1,3,5-triazine, sodium salts (CAS No. 191877-09-5) (provided for in subheading 3204.16.30)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
