A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CODY GRATER POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 19101 Cortez Boulevard in

1 Brooksville, Florida, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Cody Grater Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Cody Grater Post
7 Office Building”.

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
