## A BILL

To authorize discretionary appropriations to carry out the Service Members Occupational Conversion and Training Act of 1992.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "SMOCTA Reauthor-  
5 ization Act of 2008".

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR SERV-**  
2 **ICE MEMBERS OCCUPATIONAL CONVERSION**  
3 **AND TRAINING ACT.**

4 In addition to amounts made available under section  
5 4495 of the Service Members Occupational Conversion  
6 and Training Act of 1992 (10 U.S.C. 1143 note; subtitle  
7 G of title XLIV of division D of Public Law 102–484 (106  
8 Stat. 2757 et seq.)), there is authorized to be appropriated  
9 to carry out such Act—

- 10 (1) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2009;  
11 (2) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2010;  
12 (3) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2011;  
13 (4) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2012;  
14 (5) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2013;  
15 (6) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2014;  
16 (7) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2015;  
17 (8) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2016;  
18 (9) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2017; and  
19 (10) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2018.
