## A BILL

To extend through 2013 the authority of the Federal Election Commission to impose civil money penalties on the basis of a schedule of penalties established and published by the Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY AU-**  
4 **THORITY OF FEDERAL ELECTION COMMIS-**  
5 **SION THROUGH 2013.**

6 (a) EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.—Section  
7 309(a)(4)(C) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of

1 1971 (2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(4)(C)) is amended by adding at  
2 the end the following new clause:

3 “(iv) This subparagraph shall apply with respect to  
4 violations that relate to reporting periods that begin on  
5 or after January 1, 2000, and that end on or before De-  
6 cember 31, 2013.”.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 640 of the  
8 Treasury and General Government Appropriations Act,  
9 2000 (Public Law 106–58; 2 U.S.C. 437g note) is amend-  
10 ed by striking subsection (c).

11 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
12 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-  
13 ment of the Treasury and General Government Appropria-  
14 tions Act, 2000.
