## A BILL

To require the sale of certain defense articles and defense  
services to Taiwan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO SELL CERTAIN DEFENSE AR-**  
4 **TICLES AND DEFENSE SERVICES TO TAIWAN.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENT.—In accordance with section 3(a)  
6 of the Taiwan Relations Act, the defense articles and de-  
7 fense services described in subsection (b) shall be trans-  
8 ferred on a sales basis to Taiwan as soon as practicable  
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

1 (b) DEFENSE ARTICLES AND DEFENSE SERVICES  
2 DESCRIBED.—The defense articles and defense services  
3 referred to in subsection (a) are the following:

4 (1) The unfulfilled elements of the request  
5 made by Taiwan and approved by President George  
6 W. Bush in 2001 that includes diesel electric sub-  
7 marines or relevant designs, Mark-48 ASW tor-  
8 pedoes, Harpoon submarine-launched anti-ship  
9 cruise missiles, PAC-3 missile defense systems, Pal-  
10 adin self-propelled howitzers, Apache helicopters,  
11 and mine-sweeping helicopters.

12 (2) 66 F-16 C/D fighter planes that were re-  
13 quested by the Government of Taiwan in August  
14 2007.

15 (c) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION AND AP-  
16 PROVAL.—The requirement to transfer defense articles  
17 and defense services under subsection (a) shall be carried  
18 out notwithstanding the provisions for congressional noti-  
19 fication and approval of a proposed sale of defense articles  
20 or defense services in section 36(b) of the Arms Export  
21 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)).
