## A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a commemorative postage  
stamp in honor of George Henry White.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GEORGE HENRY WHITE COMMEMORATIVE**  
4 **POSTAGE STAMP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Postmaster General shall  
6 issue a commemorative postage stamp in honor of George  
7 Henry White.

8 (b) SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS.—Such stamp—

9 (1) shall be issued in the denomination used for  
10 first class mail up to one ounce in weight;

1           (2) shall bear such designs as the Postmaster  
2           General shall determine; and

3           (3) shall be placed on sale as soon as prac-  
4           ticable after the date of the enactment of this Act  
5           and shall be sold for such period thereafter as the  
6           Postmaster General shall determine.
