RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1294) to extend Federal recognition to the Chickahominy Indian Tribe, the Chickahominy Indian Tribe—Eastern Division, the Upper Mattaponi Tribe, the Rappahannock Tribe, Inc., the Monacan Indian Nation, and the Nansemond Indian Tribe.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 1294) to extend Federal recognition to the Chickahominy

1 Indian Tribe, the Chickahominy Indian Tribe—Eastern
2 Division, the Upper Mattaponi Tribe, the Rappahannock
3 Tribe, Inc., the Monacan Indian Nation, and the
4 Nansemond Indian Tribe. All points of order against con-
5 sideration of the bill are waived except those arising under
6 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the nature
7 of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural
8 Resources now printed in the bill, modified by the amend-
9 ments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules
10 to accompany this resolution, shall be considered as adopt-
11 ed. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All
12 points of order against the bill, as amended, are waived.
13 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
14 the bill, as amended, to final passage without intervening
15 motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as
16 amended, equally divided and controlled by the chairman
17 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-
18 ural Resources; and (2) one motion to recommit with or
19 without instructions.

20 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 1294 pursuant
21 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
22 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
23 eration of the bill to such time as may be designated by
24 the Speaker.
