A BILL

To require that funds awarded to States and political subdivisions for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program be distributed not later than 120 days after the last day of the annual application period.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensure Timely SCAAP
5 Reimbursement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISTRIBUTION OF SCAAP COMPENSATION.**

2 Section 241(i) of the Immigration and Nationality
3 Act (8 U.S.C. 1231(i)) is amended by adding at the end
4 the following:

5 “(7) Any funds awarded to a State or a polit-
6 ical subdivision of a State, including a municipality,
7 for a fiscal year under this subsection shall be dis-
8 tributed to such State or political subdivision not
9 later than 120 days after the last day of the applica-
10 tion period for assistance under this subsection for
11 that fiscal year.”.
