## A BILL

To provide for the release of certain land from the Sunrise Mountain Instant Study Area in the State of Nevada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Orchard Detention  
5 Basin Flood Control Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF CERTAIN LAND IN THE SUNRISE**  
7 **MOUNTAIN INSTANT STUDY AREA.**

8 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that the land de-  
9 scribed in subsection (c) has been adequately studied for  
10 wilderness designation under section 603 of the Federal

1 Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C.  
2 1782).

3 (b) RELEASE.—The land described in subsection  
4 (c)—

5 (1) is no longer subject to section 603(c) of the  
6 Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976  
7 (43 U.S.C. 1782(c)); and

8 (2) shall be managed in accordance with—

9 (A) land management plans adopted under  
10 section 202 of that Act (43 U.S.C. 1712); and

11 (B) cooperative conservation agreements in  
12 existence on the date of the enactment of this  
13 Act.

14 (c) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The land referred to in  
15 subsections (a) and (b) is the approximately 65 acres of  
16 land in the Sunrise Mountain Instant Study Area of Clark  
17 County, Nevada, that is—

18 (1) known as the “Orchard Detention Basin”;

19 and

20 (2) designated for release on the map titled  
21 “Orchard Detention Basin” and dated March 18,  
22 2005.
