A BILL

To rename the Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historic Site in the State of Kentucky as the “Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historical Park”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Abraham Lincoln
5 Birthplace National Historical Park Act of 2008”.

1 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

2 Congress finds that—

3 (1) the Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National
4 Historic Site was established by Congress on July
5 17, 1916;

6 (2) section 510 of Public Law 105–355 (16
7 U.S.C. 218a) authorized the addition to the Historic
8 Site of the 228-acre Knob Creek Farm at which
9 Abraham Lincoln lived between 1811 and 1816;

10 (3) Knob Creek Farm was donated to the Na-
11 tional Historic Site in November 2001; and

12 (4) the 2006 General Management Plan for the
13 Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historic Site
14 recommends a change in the name of the Historic
15 Site to “National Historical Park” to reflect the ad-
16 dition of a second, noncontiguous unit.

17 **SEC. 3. DESIGNATION OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN BIRTHPLACE**
18 **NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

19 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN BIRTHPLACE**
20 **NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

21 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Abraham Lincoln Birth-
22 place National Historic Site in the State of Kentucky shall
23 be known and designated as the “Abraham Lincoln Birth-
24 place National Historical Park”.

25 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
26 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National His-
2 toric Site shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Abra-
3 ham Lincoln Birthplace National Historical Park”.
