A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to add crimes committed in Indian country or exclusive Federal jurisdiction as racketeering predicates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CRIMES COMMITTED IN INDIAN COUNTRY OR**
4 **EXCLUSIVE FEDERAL JURISDICTION AS**
5 **RACKETEERING PREDICATES.**

6 Section 1961(1)(A) of title 18, United States Code,
7 is amended by inserting “, or would have been so charge-
8 able if the act or threat (other than gambling conducted
9 pursuant to Federal law) had not been committed in In-
10 dian country (as defined in section 1151) or in any other

1 area of exclusive Federal jurisdiction,” after “chargeable
2 under State law”.
