## A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to prohibit the imposition of a fee or tax for direct gaseous emissions by livestock.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Livestock Emissions  
5 Tax Ban Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF FEE OR TAX FOR**  
7 **DIRECT GASEOUS EMISSIONS BY LIVESTOCK.**

8 Title III of the Clean Air Act is amended—

9 (1) by inserting after section 312 (42 U.S.C.  
10 7612) the following:

1 **“SEC. 313. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF FEE OR TAX**  
2 **FOR DIRECT GASEOUS EMISSIONS BY LIVE-**  
3 **STOCK.**

4 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-  
5 ministrator shall not impose a fee or tax under this Act  
6 on any direct gaseous emissions by livestock.”; and

7 (2) by redesignating the second section 317 (42  
8 U.S.C. 7617) (relating to economic impact assess-  
9 ment) as section 318.
