Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Griselda Lopez Negrete.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Griselda Lopez Negrete shall be considered
7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
8 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
9 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent resident status to
12 Griselda Lopez Negrete, as provided in section 1, the Sec-

1 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce
2 by 1 during the current or next following fiscal year the
3 total number of immigrant visas available to natives of the
4 country of the birth of Griselda Lopez Negrete under sec-
5 tion 202(a)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
6 U.S.C. 1152(a)(2)).
