# **A BILL**

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the Magna Water District water reuse and groundwater recharge project, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Magna Water District  
5 Water Reuse and Groundwater Recharge Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAGNA WATER DISTRICT.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
8 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (43 U.S.C. 390h  
9 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following:

10 **“SEC. 16 \_\_\_\_ . MAGNA WATER DISTRICT WATER REUSE AND**  
11 **GROUNDWATER RECHARGE PROJECT, UTAH.**

12       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
13 tion with the Magna Water District, Utah, may partici-  
14 pate in the design, planning, and construction of perma-  
15 nent facilities needed to establish recycled water distribu-  
16 tion and wastewater treatment and reclamation facilities  
17 that will be used to provide recycled water in the Magna  
18 Water District.

19       “(b) COST SHARING.—

20               “(1) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of  
21 the capital cost of the project described in subsection  
22 (a) shall not exceed 25 percent of the total cost of  
23 the project.

24               “(2) NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—Each cost in-  
25 curred by the Magna Water District after January

1 1, 2003, relating to any capital, planning, design,  
2 permitting, construction, or land acquisition (includ-  
3 ing the value of reallocated water rights) for the  
4 project described in subsection (a) shall be credited  
5 towards the non-Federal share of the costs of the  
6 project.

7 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary  
8 shall not be used for operation or maintenance of the  
9 project described in subsection (a).

10 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
11 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
12 \$12,000,000.”.

13 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-  
14 tions in section 2 of the Reclamation Projects Authoriza-  
15 tion and Adjustment Act of 1992 (43 U.S.C. prec. 371)  
16 is amended by inserting after the item relating to section  
17 16\_\_\_\_ the following:

“Sec. 16\_\_\_\_. Magna Water District water reuse and groundwater recharge  
project, Utah.”.



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
