A BILL

To rename the Ocmulgee National Monument.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OCMULGEE NATIONAL MONUMENT RENAMED.**

4 The Act of June 14, 1934, (Chapter 519; 48 Stat.
5 958; 16 U.S.C. 447a–447c) is amended by adding at the
6 end the following:

7 “SEC. 4. Notwithstanding section 1, the Ocmulgee
8 National Monument shall be known as the Ocmulgee
9 Mounds National Monument. Any reference in a law, map,
10 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
11 States to the Ocmulgee National Monument is deemed to

1 be a reference to the Ocmulgee Mounds National Monu-
2 ment.”.
