3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The annex building under construction for the United
5 States courthouse located 56 Forsyth Street in Atlanta,
6 Georgia, know as the Elbert P. Tuttle United States Court

1 of Appeals Building, shall be known and designated as the
2 “John C. Godbold United States Judicial Administration
3 Building”.

4 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

5 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
6 paper, or other record of the United States to the annex
7 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
8 a reference to the “John C. Godbold United States Judi-
9 cial Administration Building”.
