A BILL

To repeal provisions of the recently enacted health care reform law that prohibit health coverage rescissions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Health Insurance
5 Protects America—Can’t Repeal IT (HIPA–CRIT) Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF HEALTH CARE REFORM PROHIBITION**

7 **ON RESCISSIONS.**

8 The provisions of the Patient Protection and Afford-
9 able Care Act (Public Law 111–148), insofar as such Act
10 under section 2712 of the Public Health Service Act (42

1 U.S.C. 300gg-12) prohibits a group health plan and a
2 health insurance issuer offering group or individual health
3 insurance coverage from rescinding such plan or coverage
4 with respect to an enrollee once the enrollee is covered
5 under such plan or coverage involved and requires prior
6 notice to an enrollee before such a plan or coverage is can-
7 celled, are hereby repealed, effective as of the date of the
8 enactment of this Act.

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
