A BILL

To convey the New River State Park campground located in the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area in the Jefferson National Forest in Carroll County, Virginia, to the Commonwealth of Virginia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, MOUNT ROGERS NA-**
2 **TIONAL RECREATION AREA, JEFFERSON NA-**
3 **TIONAL FOREST, VIRGINIA.**

4 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Ag-
5 riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the Com-
6 monwealth of Virginia, all right, title, and interest of the
7 United States in and to the federally owned land under
8 jurisdiction of the Secretary consisting of the approxi-
9 mately 78.15 acres (and all buildings and amenities within
10 those acres) located in the Mount Rogers National Recre-
11 ation Area in the Jefferson National Forest in Carroll
12 County, Virginia, as generally depicted on the map enti-
13 tled “Potential Conveyance of the New River Campground
14 to the Commonwealth of Virginia” and dated May 1,
15 2008.

16 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
17 and legal description of the land to be conveyed under sub-
18 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory
19 to the Secretary. The cost of the survey and all other costs
20 incurred by the Secretary to convey the land shall be borne
21 by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

22 (c) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The conveyance
23 authorized under subsection (a) shall be subject to the
24 condition that the Commonwealth of Virginia accept the
25 real property described in such subsection in its condition

1 at the time of conveyance (commonly known as conveyance
2 “as is”).

3 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
4 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
5 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
6 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
7 interests of the United States.

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
